The 70th anniversary celebrations of our flagship children's centre in Afula saw a series of emotional reunions for Holocaust survivors who grew up there, having escaped Nazi persecution. ## CASH FOR CRISIS CENTRE

The cost of developing Emunah's Sarah Ronson Crisis and Intervention Centre and meeting the increased demand for services, will be over £500,000. "There has been a sharp increase in the number of cases involving sexual abuse," explains Centre Director Tami Beck. "We urgently need more therapists with expertise in this field and due to lack of space, we

have waiting lists of people needing psychotherapy and specialist help, as well as supporting people suffering from anxiety and PTSD due to Gaza rocket and terror attacks. Over 80 percent of our clients are under 18. We desperately need British Emunah's help, as without your support we would not be able to meet the needs of so many clients."



## GAN YACHAD PEDAL PUSH

Children from Gan Yachad Nursery in Finchley rode scooters and bikes for a sponsored pedal push to raise £255 for Emunah. "It's about young children raising money for children in Israel who aren't as lucky as they are – that's why we like doing this event," said nursery head Reva Ross. 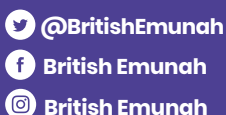
